

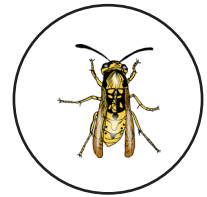
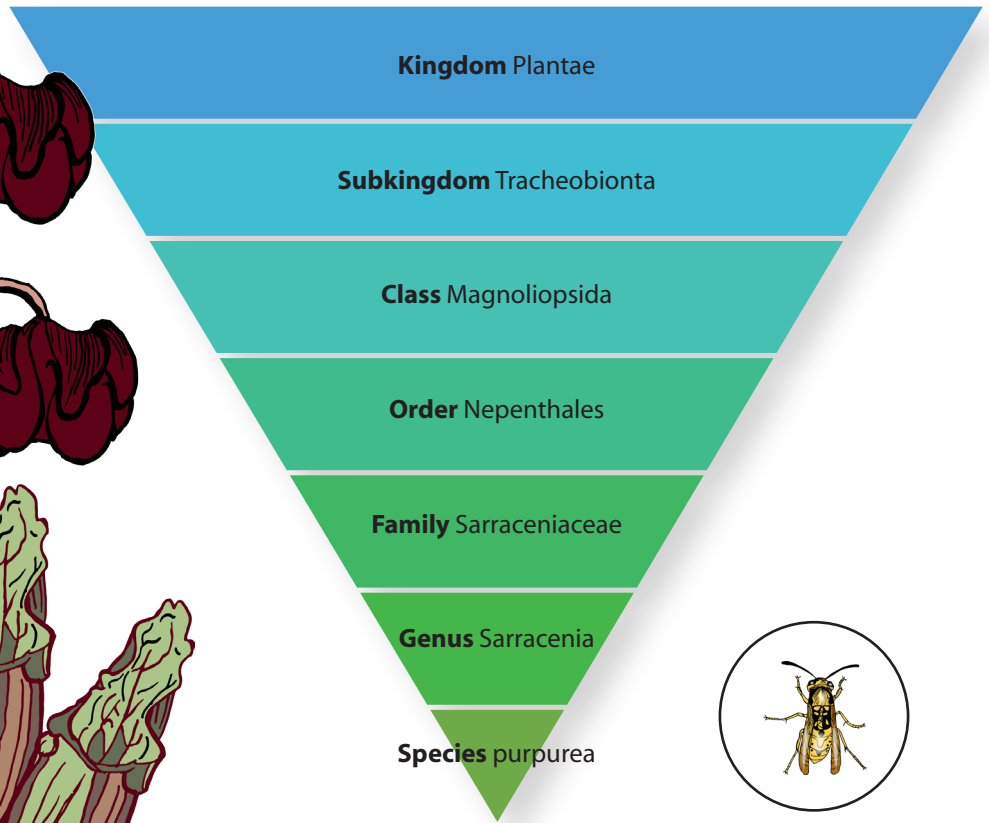
# Sarracenia purpurea subsp. venosa

## Nicknames

Pitcher plant

## Sarracenia purpurea subsp. venosa



Insects can be placed in pitchers as a snack.



Keep a dish underneath the pot to keep soil wet. The pots should always be sitting in about 4 to 6 cm of water. Sarracenia should never be allowed to dry out.



Requires reduced light and cold temperatures for 3 – 4 months.



They can be kept indoors, but only if given a grow light. Even if kept indoors, they still require a dormancy period.



Throughout Canada and the Eastern coast of the United States.



12-16 hours of bright sunlight during the growing season.



Equal parts sand and sphagnum peat moss.
