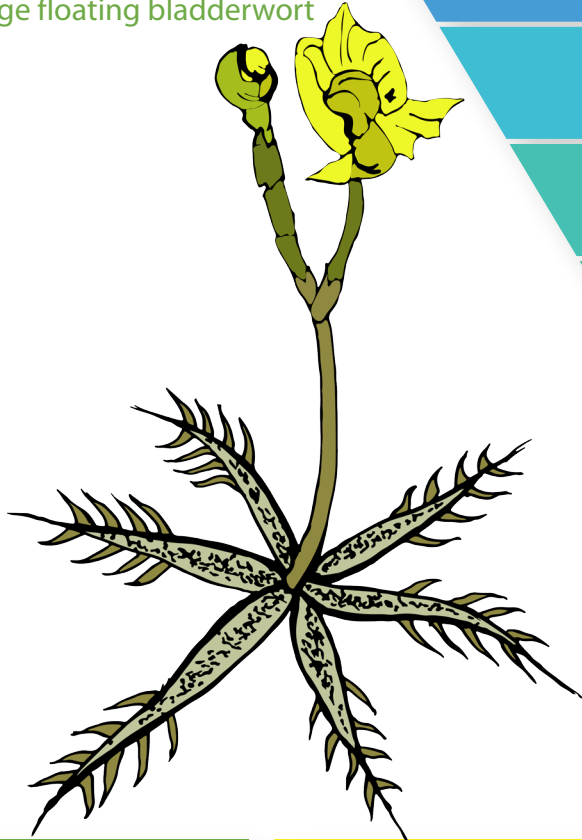


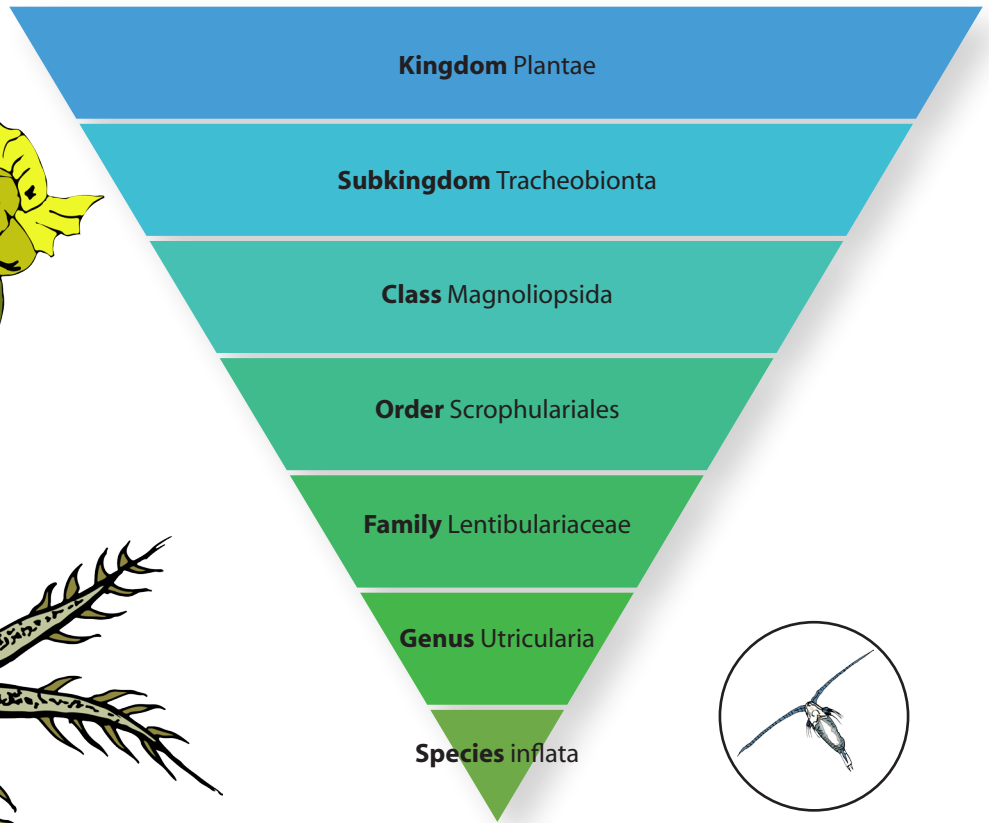
Utricularia inflata

Utricularia inflata



Add spoonful's of pond water to introduce infauna to the pond or tank.



Grows floating in dark, tea colored water caused by tannins. Does well in a pond with other aquatic plants such as water lilies, frogbit, and pickerel weed.



Does not require dormancy but will die back and form turions (overwintering bud) if temperature drop below 55 F.



Can be grown in an aquarium with tannin rich water.



Southeastern, United States.



Partial sun to full sun.



This is an aquatic plant that grows in bog water without anchoring roots.



Small invertebrates like protozoa and rotifers.
